3.	<b>Chenin Torrontes, Santa Rosa, Argentina</b> Hints of pear and quince on the nose with Torrontes adding honeyed richness to the blend. Off dry in style.	£3.40	£13.50
4.	<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Stella Bella, Margaret River, Australia</b> A stunning example of cooler climate Sauvignon Blanc. Zesty, with hints of orange blossom on the nose and crisp, dry palate. All you expect from a great Sauvignon!	£4.75	£18.95

9. **Pierre Mignon "Grande Reserve" Brut, France** £30.00  
A crisp, well balanced Champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish. Fabulous with a plate of oysters!
10. **Pierre Mignon "Grande Reserve" Brut HALVES** £18.00
11. **Pommery Pop, France** £12.95  
POP is the first Champagne specially made to be consumed straight from the bottle or with a straw.
12. **Pommery Brut Royal, France** £39.50  
Fresh, elegant and lively style of Champagne. Bottle age lends complexity and great winemaking adds style. Refreshing and palate-stimulating!
13. **Bollinger "Special Cuvee", France** £52.00  
Full bodied Champagne which has a good mature flavour and a long lasting "mousse".

## ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE

14. **Pierre Mignon Rose Brut, France** £34.00  
A beautifully coloured Rose with delicate red berry fruit on the nose with hints of biscuity complexity. Bright, juicy and creamy.
15. **Laurent Perrier Rose, France** £69.00  
The fashion statement in Champagne! Elegant, crisp with soft, strawberry like fruit and a long creamy finish.

## SPARKLING

16. **Prosecco, Cielo & Terra, Italy** £15.85  
Aromatic apple and pear flavours on the nose followed by a crisp palate.
17. **Hillsview Sparkling, Australia** £16.95  
A lively, citrus scented sparkler with a creamy, vibrant mousse.
18. **Miret Cava Rosado Reserva, Spain** £17.50  
Pure red fruits on the nose and sweet cherries and strawberries on the palate.
19. **Vida Organica Sparkling, Argentina** £22.00  
Citrus fruit character rounded with hints of peach and it's organic.
20. **Pelorus Sparkling, New Zealand** £29.50  
Cloudy Bay's premium sparkling wine. Full and lively with well balanced, crisp fruit and a long, complex finish.

21.	<b>Colombard/Sauvignon/Riesling, Tiddy Widdy Well, Australia</b> Aromatic and vibrant on the nose with a palate of fresh grapefruit, guava and mango.	£14.50
22.	<b>Viognier, Santa Rosa, Argentina</b> Apricot fruit with just a touch of spice. Interesting, just that little bit different dry white. Try with the Thai Fish Cakes.	£14.90
23.	<b>Muscadet de Sevre et Maine Sur Lie, "Les Vignes Blanches", Domaine Menard Gaborit, France</b> A real classic - bone dry with good depth of flavour and fruit. Excellent with simple shellfish.	£15.50
24.	<b>Gruner Veltliner QbA, Stadt Krems, Austria</b> Perfect partner to grilled fish! Away from all the Chardonnays and Sauvignon Blancs, this wine has an interesting palate of ripe apple with a touch of minerality, just off dry in style.	£18.50
25.	<b>Pinot Grigio, Villa Brunasca, Italy</b> Full flavoured and ripe style of Pinot Grigio from a small private Estate in Veneto. Best enjoyed with a plate of grilled prawns or langoustines.	£19.50
26.	<b>Sauvignon Blanc, El Delirio, Chile</b> An elegant, crisp example with fresh citrus notes accompanied by a beautifully textured palate and long finish.	£19.95
27.	<b>Chardonnay, Shelmerdine, Australia</b> On the nose there are hints of white peach and apricot kernel coupled with subtle, toasty, oak driven notes. The palate is full and complex yet also restrained and balanced so as not to overpower. The creamy texture of the wine is tempered with a crisp, mineral finish.	£21.50
28.	<b>Verdejo Veracruz, Spain</b> Very Sauvignon like but with more weight and panache. This truly is a world beater and it has the accolades to prove it - the 2003 vintage was the first Spanish white to win Gold at the International Wine challenge for over 6 years!	£22.00
29.	<b>Riesling, Sherwood Estate, New Zealand</b> Well balanced, crisp and rounded, showing good concentration of tangy lime fruit character offset by a touch of honey. Fabulous with smoked fish.	£22.50
30.	<b>Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Moreux, France</b> Classic dry, steely Sauvignon fruit with subtle smoky grapefruit character and an intense core of crisp, mineral fruit. Elegant and long.	£24.50
31.	<b>Tokay - Pinot Gris, Caves JB Adam, France</b> A full bodied white with richer honeyed fruit character. A great food wine that in its Alsace home accompanies all types of meat.	£25.50
32.	<b>Chablis, Domaine Defaix, France</b> A top notch example from a respected grower. Defaix Chablis displays mineral, flinty notes on the nose with touches of green apple. Simply amazing with a plate of langoustines.	£25.90
33.	<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Stoney Vineyard, Tasmania</b> This wine exhibits a pure, crisp palate of grassy, herbaceous fruit with hints of pear, peach and apricot.	£29.90
34.	<b>Chablis 1er Cru Montmains, Domaine Denis Race, France</b> A crisp, steely wine with medium weight citrus fruit and hints of mineral. Elegant yet well concentrated, this is a great wine with serious fish dishes and light white meats.	£35.90

36.	<b>Shiraz/Cabernet/Merlot , Tiddy Widdy Well, Australia</b> Upfront fruit, soft tannins, rich, concentrated palate and a long ripe finish. Great complexity and length, and real finesse.	£14.50
37.	<b>Beaujolais Villages, Domaine Dubost, France</b> A succulent, juicy red with ripe raspberry fruit and soft supple tannins.	£17.90
38.	<b>Rioja Crianza, Luis Canas, Spain</b> All time favourite red! Complex with well balanced with a soft, sweetish oak finish.	£19.90
39.	<b>Pinotage, Virgin Earth, South Africa</b> Full of ripe, spicy bramble and plum fruit with hints of woodsmoke and vanilla adding complexity.	£22.50
40.	<b>Carmenere, La Porfia, Chile</b> Rich, silky smooth with a hint of spice. Bramble and red cherry fruit with light oak and soft tannin structure.	£24.50
