2. Chardonnay, Costa Vera, Chile A crisp, unwooded style of Chardonnay with lively lemony fruit character and refreshing pear and apple finish.	£16.50	£4.40	£3.30

8. Tempranillo/Syrah, Castillo Del Moro, Spain A silky smooth red with plump ripe dark fruits, smoky spices and a succulent finish. Ripened in the warm Spanish sunshine, this red is ideal with charcuterie, red meats and stews.	£14.95	£4.00	£3.00

13. Pierre Mignon, Grand Reserve, France	£20.50	
A crisp, well balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.		
14. Pommery Brut Royal, France	£49.00	
Fresh, elegant and lively style of Champagne. Bottle age lends complexity and great wine making adds style. Refreshing and palate stimulating!		
15. Bollinger "Special Cuvee", France	£65.00	
Full bodied Champagne which has a good mature flavour and a long lasting "mousse".		
16. Cristal Brut Vintage, France	£180.00	
Very fine and complex with delicate nuances of ripe apple and brioche coupled with lively, persistent and very fine mousse.		
17. Laurent Perrier Rosé, France	£84.50	
The fashion statement in Champagne! Elegant, crisp with soft, strawberry like fruit and a long creamy finish.		
18. Prosecco, Cielo and Terra, Italy	£19.50	£3.75
Aromatic apple and pear flavours on the nose followed by a crisp palate.		
19. Miret Cava Rosado Reserva, Spain	£19.95	
Pure red fruits on the nose and sweet cherries and strawberries on the palate.		
20. Pelorus Sparkling, New Zealand	£39.50	£7.50
Cloudy Bay's premium sparkling wine. Full and lively with well balanced, crisp fruit and a long, complex finish.

21. Muscadet Sur Lie, Abbaye de Sainte Radegonde, France A real classic - bone dry with good depth of flavour and fruit. Excellent with simple shellfish.	£21.50
22. Chablis 1er Cru Montmains, Denis Race, France A steely wine with medium weight citrus fruit and hints of mineral. Elegant yet well concentrated, this is a great wine with serious fish dishes and light white meats.	£40.50
23. Sauvignon Blanc Reserve, Nostros, Chile Sourced from Casablanca, this is a pure, exuberantly fruity Sauvignon full of grassy, tropical fruit. Instantly refreshing and moreish with a lovely tangy finish.	£18.50
24. Pinot Grigio, "Priaro", Pradio - Italy This Estate grown Pinot Grigio bursts into the mouth with delicious floral, pear and honeysuckle notes, offering so much more character and depth than some. Lovely texture and balanced citrus on the finish pulls this into a perfectly formed wine.	£25.50
25. Picpoul de Pinet, Coteaux de Languedoc, Domaine De Montredon, France Made from the old southern French variety Picpoul, this is becoming something of a cult wine. On the nose there are citrus notes and just a hint of saltiness. The palate is lively and fresh. A classic match for oysters and seafood.	£21.95
26. Chardonnay, Duetto, Chile Shiny gold colour with honey touches. Wonderful sweet fruits aromas with mineral hints. On the palate it is creamy, well rounded and vibrant with a comfortable acidity. Very elegant.	£29.50
27. Albarino, Lagar de Bouza, Spain Albarino has long been likened to Riesling for its lemony, crisp style but this indigenous grape of the region of Galicia has a personality very much of its own. Great with shellfish.	£27.50
28. Sauvignon /Riesling "The Opportunist" One Chain, Australia Vibrant, grassy, grapefruit tinged fruit is testament to the work of an Opportunist.	£19.95
29. Sauvignon Blanc, Zephyr, New Zealand Intensely aromatic with guava, mango, passion fruit, asparagus and grass leading to a richly textured palate of. Stunning.	£29.50
30. Viognier, Santa Rosa, Argentina Apricot fruit with just a touch of spice. Interesting, just that little bit different dry white. Try with the Thai Fish Cakes.	£19.50
31. Sauvignon Blanc, Barrel Fermented, Amayna, Chile Ripe tropical fruit blends with mineral notes and luscious vanilla from it's elegant oak treatment. Great aromatic complexity.	£41.50
32. Gruner Veltliner Federspiel Terrasen, Wachau, Austria Delicious, marked white pepper, grapefruit and citrus aromas, elegant and long on the palate.	£24.50
33. Puligny Montrachet, Lucien Muzart, France Intensely concentrated and fine, possessing lovely mineral and citrus characters coupled with hints of nuts and butter.	£76.00

34. **Old Vine Garnacha, "Pereza", Los Pecalillos, Spain** £20.50
Sourced from old, gnarly vines that produce small quantities of intense, concentrated fruit, Pereza Rosado is wildly scented, ripe and richly textured. Delicious tangy strawberry and damson fruits follows through to a crisp, moreish finish.

RED WINES

35. **Beaujolais Villages, Domaine de Colette, France** £24.50
This moreish red is produced from hand selected Gamay grapes to yield a medium bodied, succulent young red with lots of raspberry, redcurrant and strawberry fruit.
36. **Carmenere, Armador, Chile** £23.50
Stunning value Carmenere that really shows the potential of this variety when fully ripe. Savoury, creamy and lush with spicy olive laced flavour.
37. **Chateuneuf du Pape Rouge, Domaine du Vieux Lazaret, France** £46.50
A big full bodied wine with plenty of flavour and character. Spicy bramble and red berry fruit.
38. **Rioja Crianza, Luis Canas, Spain** £25.95
All time favourite red! Complex, well balanced with a soft, sweetish oak finish.
39. **Shiraz "Angels Share", Two Hands, Australia** £46.00
One of the best examples of Australian Shiraz, rich spice and pepper with silky tannins. Robert Parker gave this wine 95 points.
40. **Shiraz "The Opportunist", One Chain, Australia** £19.95
A deep, inviting crimson black with an intense cassis, plum and bramble nose. Rich, voluptuous and silky on the palate with creamy black fruits and a little savoury smokiness from oak.
41. **Pinotage, Hidden Valley, South Africa** £27.50
South Africa's native grape often has a few "rough edges" but this cleverly constructed wine uses a little Viognier to soften the style and give a more voluptuous character. Rich, ripe berry fruit is complimented by savoury, lightly charred wood and hints of spice. Lovely, silky texture and a warm, rich finish.
