9. **Pierre Mignon "Grande Reserve" Brut, France** £35.00  
A crisp, well balanced Champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish. Fabulous with a plate of oysters!
10. **Pierre Mignon "Grande Reserve" Brut HALVES**  
£19.00
11. **Pommery Brut Royal, France** £42.00  
Fresh, elegant and lively style of Champagne. Bottle age lends complexity and great winemaking adds style. Refreshing and palate-stimulating!
12. **Bollinger "Special Cuvee", France** £58.00  
Full bodied Champagne which has a good mature flavour and a long lasting "mousse".

## ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE

13. **Pierre Mignon Rose Brut, France** £40.00  
A beautifully coloured Rose with delicate red berry fruit on the nose with hints of biscuity complexity. Bright, juicy and creamy.
14. **Laurent Perrier Rose, France** £79.00  
The fashion statement in Champagne! Elegant, crisp with soft, strawberry like fruit and a long creamy finish.

## SPARKLING

15. **Prosecco, Cielo & Terra, Italy** £18.50  
Aromatic apple and pear flavours on the nose followed by a crisp palate.
16. **Brut Sparkling "Howzat", One Chain Vineyards, Australia** £19.50  
Fragrant and frivolous sparkler with ample pear, apple and tropical fruit character, with a crisp, citrus finish.
17. **Miret Cava Rosado Reserva, Spain** £18.90  
Pure red fruits on the nose and sweet cherries and strawberries on the palate.
18. **Vida Organica Sparkling, Argentina** £23.50  
Citrus fruit character rounded with hints of peach and it's organic.
19. **Pelorus Sparkling, New Zealand** £33.50  
Cloudy Bay's premium sparkling wine. Full and lively with well balanced, crisp fruit and a long, complex finish.

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### Bottle

20. **Muscadet de Sevre et Maine Sur Lie, "Les Vignes Blanches", Domaine Menard Gaborit, France** £17.50  
A real classic - bone dry with good depth of flavour and fruit. Excellent with simple shellfish.
21. **Chablis, Domaine Defaix, France** £28.50  
A top notch example from a respected grower. Defaix Chablis displays minerally, flinty notes on the nose with touches of green apple. Simply amazing with a plate of langoustines.
22. **Chablis 1er Cru Montmains, Domaine Denis Race, France** £39.00  
A crisp, steely wine with medium weight citrus fruit and hints of mineral. Elegant yet well concentrated, this is a great wine with serious fish dishes and light white meats.
23. **Sancerre Blanc, Domaine Moreux, France** £28.50  
Classic dry, steely Sauvignon fruit with subtle smoky grapefruit character and an intense core of crisp, minerally fruit. Elegant and long.
24. **Pinot Grigio, Villa Brunasca, Italy** £20.90  
Full flavoured and ripe style of Pinot Grigio from a small private Estate in Veneto. Best enjoyed with a plate of grilled prawns or langoustines.
25. **Verdejo Sauvignon, Mantel Blanco, Rueda, Spain** £21.90  
Wonderfully fragrant and fresh aromas of gooseberry and citrus, with a rich yet mouth-watering palate of young juicy fruit.
26. **Chardonnay, Shelmerdine, Australia** £25.50  
White peach and apricot on the nose coupled with subtle, toasty oak. The palate is full and complex, the texture is creamy and soft.
27. **Gewurztraminer, J.B. Adam, Alsace, France** £24.90  
Lychee and honeyed fruit on the nose, rich full palate slightly off dry but with good mouth cleansing acidity.
28. **Albarino, Lagar de Bouza, Spain** £23.90  
Albarino has long been likened to Riesling for its lemony, crisp style but this indigenous grape of the region of Galicia has a personality very much of its own. Paired with seafood or shellfish, is a delicate, invigorating partner.
29. **Colombard/Riesling, Tiddy Widdy Well, Australia** £15.90  
Aromatic and vibrant on the nose with a palate of fresh citrus fruit, guava and mango.
30. **Sauvignon Blanc, Sherwood Estate, New Zealand** £23.50  
Fresh, clean, bench mark New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc. Gooseberry and citrus fruit and a long refreshing finish.
31. **Viognier, Santa Rosa, Argentina** £15.90  
Apricot fruit with just a touch of spice. Interesting, just that little bit different dry white. Try with the Thai Fish Cakes.
32. **Sauvignon Blanc, Stoney Vineyard, Tasmania** £33.00  
This wine exhibits a pure, crisp palate of grassy, herbaceous fruit with hints of pear, peach and apricot.

33. **Chenin Viognier, Hidden Agenda, South Africa** £19.90  
The crisp, tangy character of Chenin coupled with the more richly textured, apricot nature of Viognier. The result is decidedly scrumptious and appetising!

## ROSE WINES

### Bottle

34. **Cabernet/Tempranillo, Rosado, Care, Spain** £19.90  
A stunning new Rose whose vibrant deep pink colour and massive concentration of ripe strawberry fruit is a feast for the senses. Crisp, juicy and succulent. Perfect with grilled salmon.

## RED WINES

35. **Savigny Les Beaune, Lucien Jacob, France** £36.50  
A soft supple Pinot with cherry and violet scents on the nose. Well balanced, bright, ripe fruit on the palate with integrated, creamy tannins and elegant wild strawberry fruit.
36. **Beaujolais Villages, Domaine Dubost, France** £19.90  
A succulent, juicy red with ripe raspberry fruit and soft supple tannins.
37. **Carmenere, La Porfia, Chile** £26.50  
Rich, silky smooth with a hint of spice. Bramble and red cherry fruit with light oak and soft tannin structure.
38. **Chateuneuf du Pape Rouge, Domaine du Vieux Lazaret, France** £39.90  
A big full bodied wine with plenty of flavour & character. Spicy bramble and red berry fruit.
39. **Rioja Crianza, Luis Canas, Spain** £24.50  
All time favourite red! Complex, well balanced with a soft, sweetish oak finish.
40. **Shiraz, Angels Share, Two Hands, Australia** £32.50  
One of the best examples of Australian Shiraz, rich spice and pepper with silky tannins. Robert Parker gave this wine 95 points.
41. **Shiraz/Cabernet/Merlot, Tiddy Widdy Well, Australia** £16.50  
Upfront fruit, soft tannins, rich, concentrated palate and a long ripe finish. Great complexity and length, and real finesse.
42. **Pinotage, Virgin Earth, South Africa** £22.90  
Full of ripe, spicy bramble and plum fruit with hints of wood smoke and vanilla adding complexity.
